

Why overcome the World?

1 John 2:15-17

Werecome - "to deprive it of power to harm, to subvert its influence,...".

What does it matter if I do or don't? (2 Timothy 1:7)

1. The desires of the flesh v.16a

- A. It refers to cravings that incite to sin.
- B. Paul describes it as illicit and/or unacceptable relationships (Cologgiang 3:5).
- C. Relationships that go against nature (Romans 1:26).
- D. Paul goes on to say that such people "come to establish these acts or practices as the center of their lives" which God calls idolatry.

2. The desires of the eyes v.16b

- A. This refers to greed.
- B. Greed "unjust gain troubles the household," (Provends 15:27).
- C. Some people like Judas base their life on having more no matter who gets hurt in the process (John 12:5-6).

3. The pride of life v.16c

- A. Refers too trusting in what can be achieved (*possessions*).
- B. The desire of enjoying possessions over God's will ([uke 12:13-21).
- C. The desire of living for yourself and not for God (Juke 16:19, 25).
