

## Who needs to overcome the World?

- C. However, Paul himself said that "God demonstrates his love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:2).
- D. The truth is that no one is worthy of salvation, that is why it is called grace.

#### 2. I don't feel like a sinner

- A. I honestly don't feel that I hurt anyone the way I live, I don't pick on anyone, I don't offend, I don't cause harm to anyone, I am not like other people. Christ spoke about this mentality through the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector (Luke 18:9-14).
- B. I know what the Word of God says, I live in a christian home (Luke 10:25-37).
- C. God deals with "self-sufficiency or self-justification".
